3. The consolidated assessment marks shall be submitted to the **Office of the Controller of Examinations latest by 10th August 2026**.
4. The **Office of the Controller of Examinations** shall conduct **End-Term Examinations (ETE)** in the conventional **Paper-Pen Mode** for all programmes and semesters that are **not covered under the University Assessment Policy**, as per the University Examination Rules.
5. The schedule and venue for assessment activities shall be notified separately by the respective Schools/Faculties.

- All Deans, Heads of Departments, Programme Coordinators and concerned officials are requested to ensure strict compliance with the above directions.
