- 6. Objective of the Activity: To observe the World Cancer Day & create awareness among the people about cancer and common oral diseases and to Promote General Health & Dental Health.
- 7. Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s)explaining activities undertaken: The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, organized the Oral Health Screening and Treatment activity on February 8, 2024 at Village



Yakubpur, Jhajjar to observe World Cancer Day. It is an international awareness day led by the Union for International Cancer Control (UICC) celebrated on February 4 every year. As per the WHO Regional Director for Africa, between 2022 and 2024, the focus of World Cancer Day is to help "close the cancer gap." To commemorate World Cancer Day, a total of 50 patients, including 20 males and 30 females were examined and 22 patients were treated at the camp site in Mobile Dental Van. Patients who required complex dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental Hospital for further procedures. An oral health talk was prepared and presented by the interns, focusing on the causes of cancer and how to prevent it using charts and models. The general population gave positive feedback and appreciated the check-up and patient care provided by the dental team. They acknowledged the way the dental team heard and attended to their problems with compassion. The purpose of the oral health check-up was to create awareness among the community and make them understand the importance of oral health.

20 patients were diagnosed with Dental Caries, 10 patients were diagnosed with Periodontal Disease 5 patients were diagnosed with Malocclusion

All the patients who required any kind of dental services were referred to SGT Dental College, Gurugram


