9	Brief Report of the event (should not exceed 500 words)	<p>On the occasion of <b>National Toothache Day</b>, The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University in collaboration with Publicity Team organized a dental camp at Majri, Haryana on 09/02/2024.</p> <p>The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Professor and Head, of Public Health Dentistry).</p> <p>The dental team was headed by Dr. Navodita Jamwal, Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health Dentistry, MDS Postgraduate student Dr Rahul, 1<sup>st</sup> year PG from Department of Public Health Dentistry along with Mr. Darshan Singh (Attendant - 1). Dental screening of 8 patients (Female – 4; Male –2) took place. By addressing the pain and discomfort associated with toothaches among the Majri village residents, this day highlights the value of preventive dental care and maintaining good oral hygiene practices.</p> <p>Positive feedback was obtained from the residents of Village Majri. Cases requiring comprehensive treatment were referred to Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University. All patients were given referral slips. They got ample opportunities to</p>

		<p>interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral health.</p> <p>Importance of maintaining good and hygienic oral health was verbally delivered to the residents by the team.
