		year PG from Department of Public Health Dentistry along with Mr. Darshan Singh		
		(Attendant - 1). Dental screening of 8 patients (Female – 4; Male –2) took place.		
		By addressing the pain and discomfort associated with toothaches among the Majri		
		village residents, this day highlights the value of preventive dental care and		
		maintaining good oral hygiene practices.		
		Positive feedback was obtained from the residents of Village Majri. Cases requiring		
		comprehensive treatment were referred to Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT		
		University. All patients were given referral slips. They got ample opportunities to
