6. Objective of the Activity:

To create awareness among the people about common oral diseases and to Promote Oral Health and to make people aware about tobacco and its ill effects.

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University in collaboration with Reliance, MET organized a dental camp on 30th May, 2024 at Dadri Toye.



The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. and Head, Public Health Dentistry). The dental team was headed by Dr. Rangoli Srivastava (Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with 5 interns – Harsimran, Prabhjot, Ekta, Palak, Rahul along with Mr. Devesh and Mr. Apran (Attendant) accompanied us. Dental checkup of 55 adults and children were done.

Emphasis was done on motivating patients to maintain good oral hygiene on account of celebration of World oral health week. Toothpaste and toothbrushes were distributed among the patients on account of the same purpose. Those who required treatment were given treatment like oral prophylaxis. Those requiring treatment were given treatment such as oral prophylaxis. Medications were prescribed and medicines were also given to them.

Focus was given on refraining from tobacco usage and its ill effects on account of World No Tobacco Day celebrated worldwide on 31st May. Children were also made aware with reference to the same. Positive feedback was obtained from participants. Cases requiring complex treatment were referred to SGT Dental College. All patients were given referral slips. The children and adults got ample opportunities to interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral diseases. Necessary oral hygiene instructions were given to required adults and children.

Importance of maintaining good and hygienic oral health was verbally delivered to the children and adults.

With the involvement of every single member of the dental team and their enormous efforts, motive of the dental camp was achieved to its maximum.





- 7. Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s) explaining activities undertaken:

In celebration of World No Tobacco Day 2024- Fortnight celebration, Department of Public Health Dentistry organized a dental camp at Jainson Eng. Pvt. Limited, Gurugram on 22nd May, 2024. The event aimed to raise awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use on oral health.

The camp included medical and dental team members, under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head, Department of Public Health Dentistry). Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health Dentistry) headed the camp along with postgraduate students- Dr. Priyanka (Dept. of Prosthodontics), Dr. Pooja (Dept. of Periodontics), Rahul, Palak, Himanshi, Mamta, Khushi, Kunal (interns)

and Mr. Sunil (support staff). Total 44 patients were examined of which 42 were males and 2 females.

One-on-one counseling sessions were provided to individuals interested in quitting tobacco. Information on nicotine replacement therapies and support groups was shared. The dental camp was a significant step towards promoting oral health and combating tobacco use in the community. In addition to this, pamphlets (IEC materials) along with oral hygiene kits were distributed to all the patients. 18 patients were provided treatment in mobile dental van. Patients requiring rigorous treatment were referred to the college with the referral slip.

- 7. Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s)explaining activities undertaken: The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, organized the Oral Health Screening and Treatment Program on June 03, 2024 at Railway Station, Garhi to create awareness among people about the harmful and deadly effects of tobacco use. A total of 36 patients, including 25 males and 11 females were examined and 10 patients were given treatment in mobile dental van at camp site. Patients who required complex dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental Hospital for further procedures. 



The patients were also given referral slips and were referred to SGT University for further needful treatment. 


