The dental team was headed by Dr. Rangoli Srivastava (Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with 5 interns – Harsimran , Prabhjot, Ekta, Palak, Rahul along with Mr. Devesh and Mr. Apran (Attendant) accompanied us. Dental checkup of 55 adults and children were done.

Emphasis was done on motivating patients to maintain good oral hygiene on account of celebration of World oral health week. Toothpaste and toothbrushes were distributed among the patients on account of the same purpose. Those who required treatment were given treatment like oral prophylaxis. Those requiring treatment were given treatment such as oral prophylaxis. Medications were prescribed and medicines were also given to them.

Focus was given on refraining from tobacco usage and its ill effects on account of World No Tobacco Day celebrated worldwide on 31st May. Children were also made aware with reference to the same. Positive feedback was obtained from participants. Cases requiring complex treatment were referred to SGT Dental College. All patients were given referral slips. The children and adults got ample opportunities to interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral diseases. Necessary oral hygiene instructions were given to required adults and children.

Importance of maintaining good and hygienic oral health was verbally delivered to the children and adults.

With the involvement of every single member of the dental team and their enormous efforts, motive of the dental camp was achieved to its maximum.

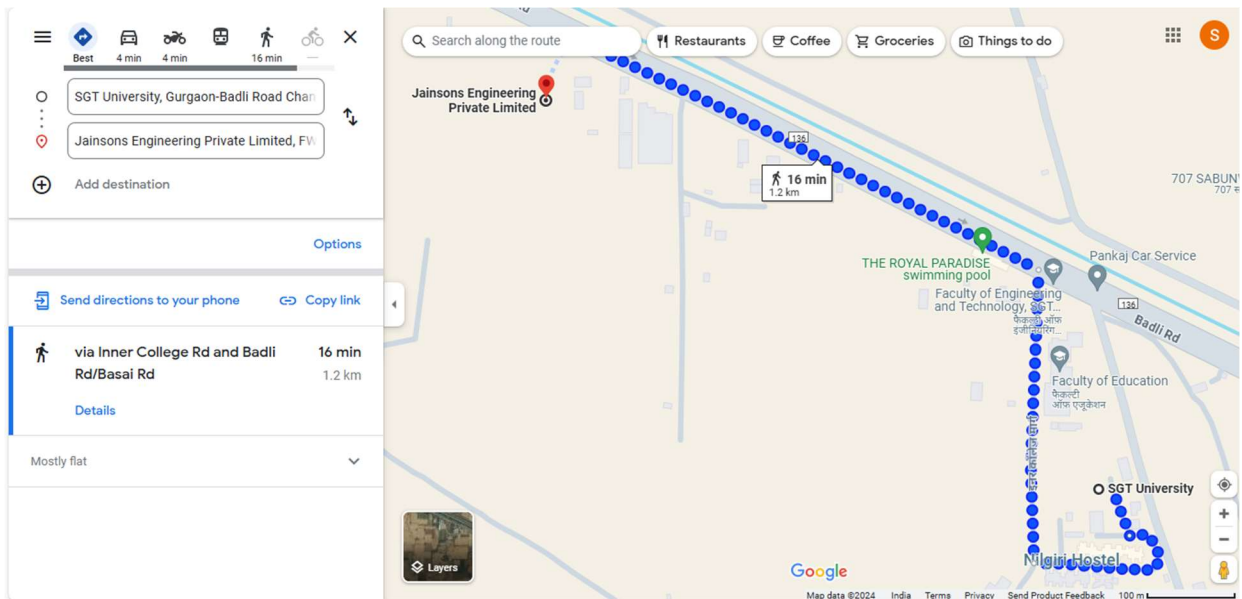

In celebration of World No Tobacco Day 2024- Fortnight celebration, Department of Public Health Dentistry organized a dental camp at Jainson Eng. Pvt. Limited, Gurugram on 22nd May, 2024. The event aimed to raise awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use on oral health.

The camp included medical and dental team members, under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head, Department of Public Health Dentistry). Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health Dentistry) headed the camp along with postgraduate students- Dr. Priyanka (Dept. of Prosthodontics), Dr. Pooja (Dept. of Periodontics), Rahul, Palak, Himanshi, Mamta, Khushi, Kunal (interns)

One-on-one counseling sessions were provided to individuals interested in quitting tobacco. Information on nicotine replacement therapies and support groups was shared. The dental camp was a significant step towards promoting oral health and combating tobacco use in the community. In addition to this, pamphlets (IEC materials) along with oral hygiene kits were distributed to all the patients. 18 patients were provided treatment in mobile dental van. Patients requiring rigorous treatment were referred to the college with the referral slip.

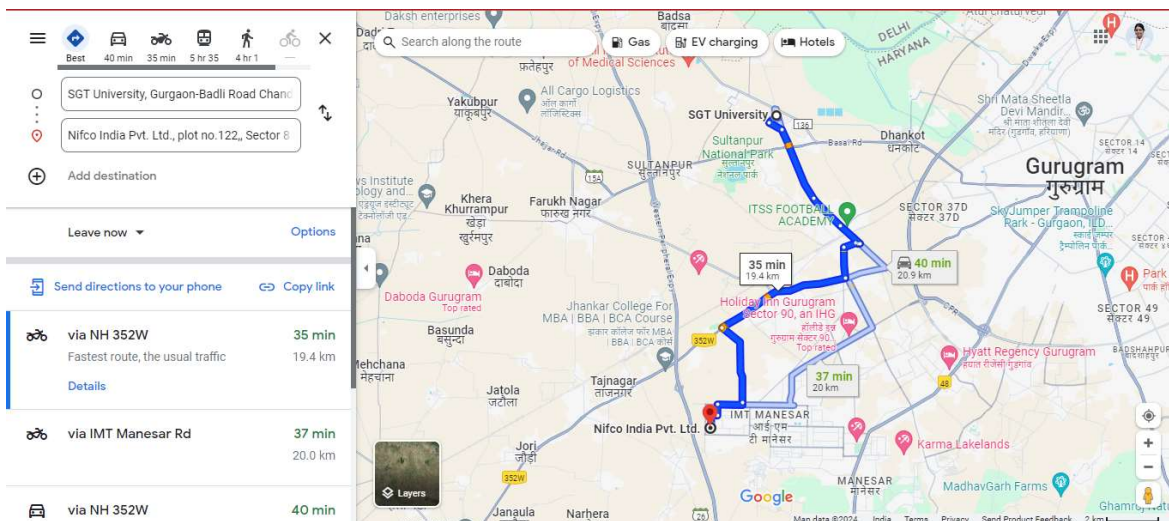

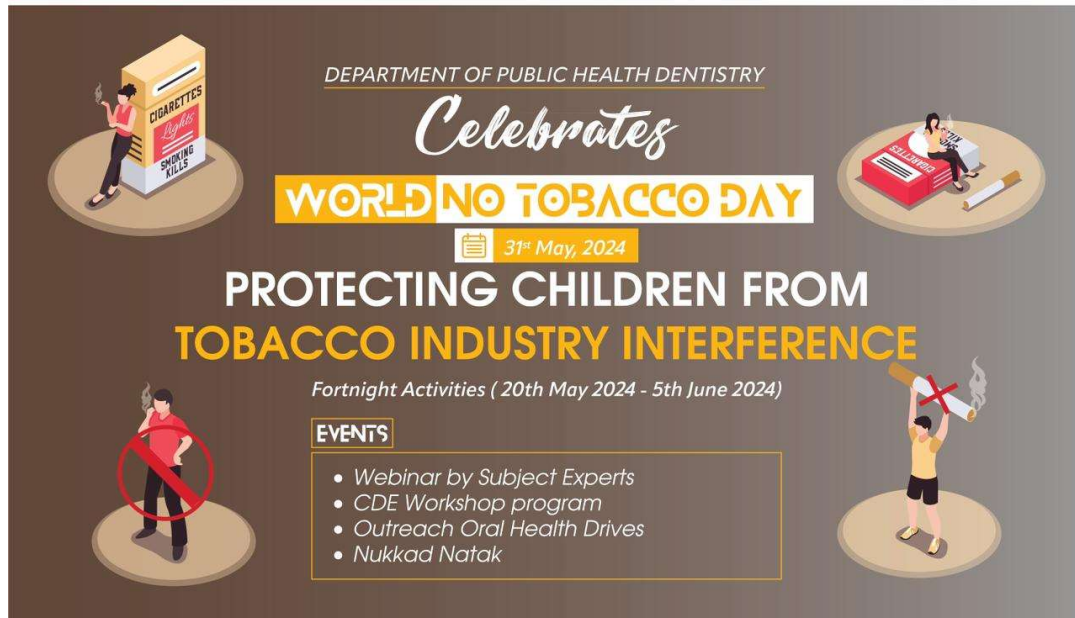

Positive feedback was obtained from the factory workers of NIFCO Manesar, Gurugram, Haryana. Cases requiring further treatment were referred to Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University, Gurugram, Haryana. All patients were given referral slips. The patients got ample opportunities to interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral health.

Importance of maintaining good and hygienic oral health was verbally delivered to the patients by faculty and the intern. On World No Tobacco Day health talk involving tobacco cessation and knowledge of deleterious effects of different forms smoke and smokeless forms of tobacco consumption were explained to the factory workers. Participants were encouraged to quit tobacco habits. Additionally, the negative effects of long-term tobacco use on health were brought to light. An oral hygiene kit consisting of a toothpaste, tooth brush and mouthwash was distributed to the patients.

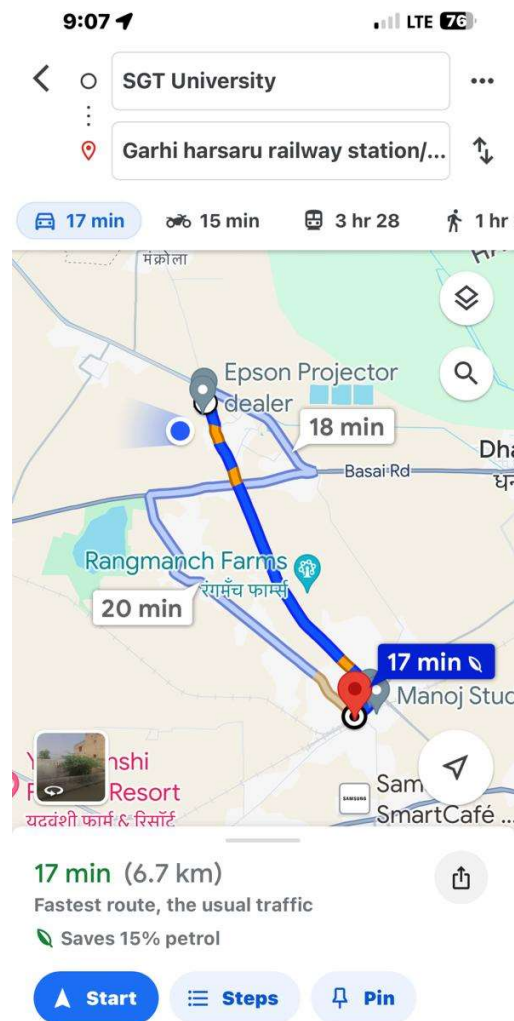

Annually World No Tobacco Day holds immense significance in combating the tobacco epidemic and promoting public health. With the theme of protecting young people from tobacco industry interference, in 2024 the Department of Public Health Dentistry & Pediatric Dentistry, FDSC, SGT University organized an awareness program at Delhi Public School, Pataudi on 27th May, 2024. The event aimed to raise awareness about the tobacco addiction and its deleterious effects on overall health amongst the 250 school children and teachers. During the formative years of life, adolescents are particularly vulnerable to experiment with tobacco consumption and leading to addiction. Talking to them about tobacco can help them understand its danger and help them make the choice to be tobacco free for life. We believe it is a high time to let the youth step in and take a stand for a healthy future. A health talk was delivered simultaneously on how to take care of the teeth, importance of brushing, proper brushing technique, balanced diet, handling dental emergencies. Essential Oral hygiene aids like toothbrush, toothpaste were distributed to the needy one's. Satisfactory feedback was obtained from the school official authorities. The patients were also given referral slips and were referred to SGT University for further needful treatment. The purpose of the dental camp was to create awareness in the community towards the importance of oral health.

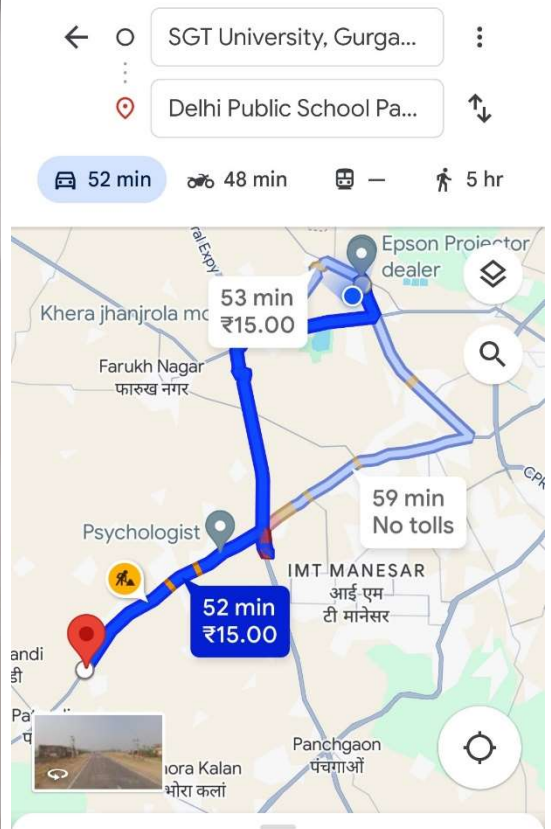

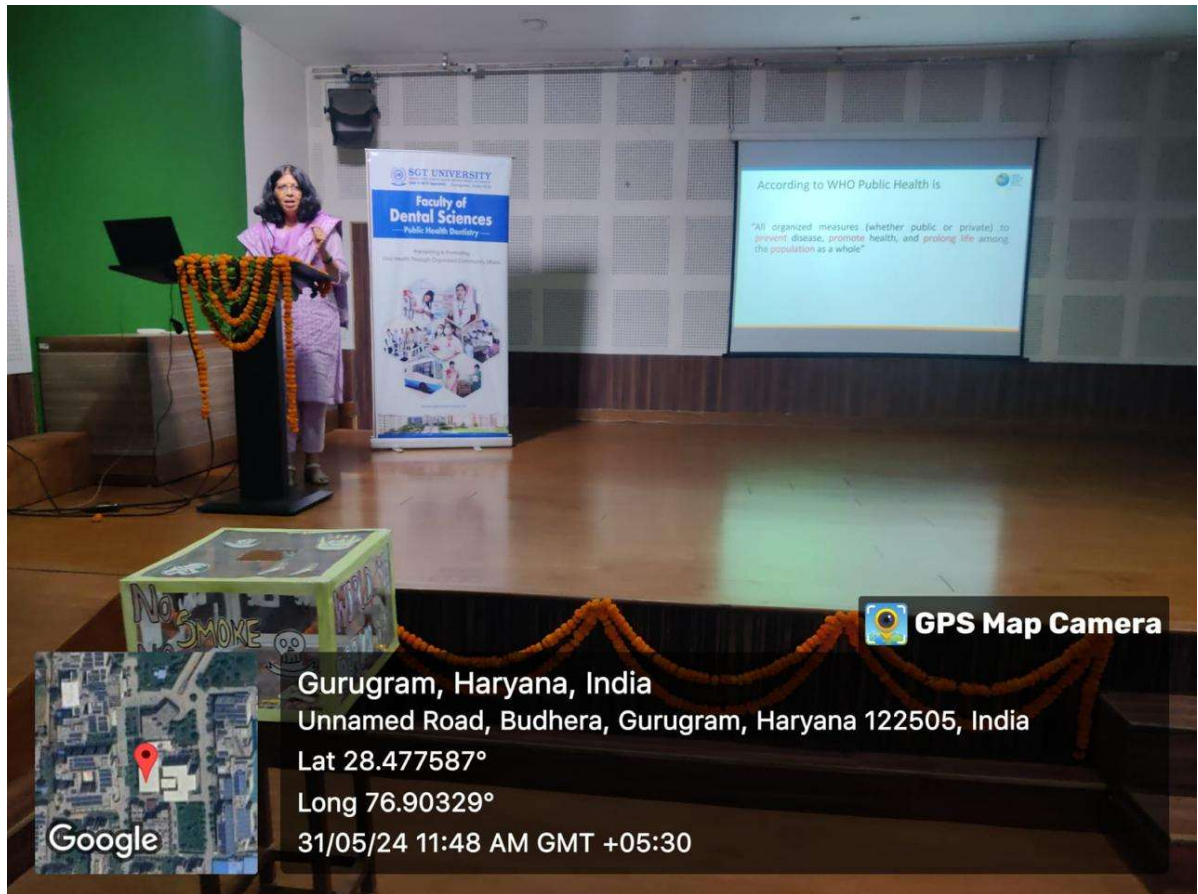
