
World Oral Health Day (WOHD) is a global observance day celebrated every year on 20th March with a motive to raise awareness of oral health and prevention of oral diseases. FDI World Dental Federation launched this day in 2013 as a flagship forum to discuss and talk about dental care and oral hygiene all over around the world.

The department of Public Health Dentistry, SGT Dental College, Hospital and Research Institute, SGT University, Gurugram observed WOHD with a series of outreach activities on oral health promotion and awareness campaign from 1st March 2024 – 5<sup>th</sup> April 2024, Webinars by Subject Experts and Scientific & Awareness Events for the students of the dental college. The outreach programs were organized daily at different peripheral locations to accomplish the motto of FDI. The idea of these activities was to reach the maximum possible target populations within this month long celebration. We were able to reach school children, rural & urban populations and specially abled population of vision impaired children.

The camps included, dental check-up, talks on importance of oral health, oral hygiene instructions, ill effects of tobacco consumption, demonstration of skills for using different oral hygiene aids, distribution of IEC materials and performance of skits/street play by dental students. All the dental patients were provided treatment in the Mobile Dental Van and referred to SGT Dental Hospital for further complex dental procedures if required.

Apart from the outreach activities, In-campus of the University, all the employees (Teaching and Non teaching) were motivated to come forward for their dental check up and learn essential oral hygiene routine during the WOHD month.

Dental faculty members, Postgraduate students and undergraduates of the faculty were all involved in these activities to make World Oral Health Day 2024 a huge success.



- All the categories of scientific competitions will be judged on 4th and 5th April 2024 at Seminar Room, Public health Dentistry Department.









The competitions attracted a diverse group of participants, including individuals of all ages interested in learning


about oral health and nutrition. The participants included BDS UG and postgraduate students.

#### Blind School Centre, Lodhi Road, New Delhi

As part of the World Oral Health Month- long activities organized by Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University, a comprehensive dental screening and treatment program was conducted at the Blind Relief Association, New Delhi on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 to assess the oral health status of visually impaired children. The activity aimed to identify dental issues, provide early interventions, and empower children with knowledge for maintaining optimal oral hygiene.

To create awareness among them, dental awareness talk was delivered, educating students about common dental ailments. Toothbrushing technique was demonstrated using dentoform model and students were made to practice the same. Each student was assisted by the dental team members during self-practice toothbrushing session.

The program conducted at the Blind Relief Association during the World Oral Health Month activities served as a critical step in assessing the oral health needs of visually impaired children. By identifying dental issues, providing personalized recommendations, and promoting preventive interventions, the screening contributed to advancing the oral health outcomes of its participants. Moving forward, ongoing efforts to prioritize oral health education and accessible dental care are essential for ensuring the well-being of visually impaired individuals and fostering inclusive healthcare practices.












**Gurgaon District Map**


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
Outcome of the Activity& its relevance to Health Sciences:




