Subject:- Procedure for admissions to MBBS & BDS Courses in Private Un-Aided Medical and Dental Educational Institutions and Institutes under Deemed Universities-Academic Session-2016.

- i The Governor of Haryana is pleased to notify following admission procedure to Under Graduate Degree Courses i.e. MBBS & BDS for the year 2016 onwards in the Private Un-Aided Medical and Dental Educational Institutions and Institutes under Deemed Universities in the State of Haryana.
- ii The Governor of Haryana is further pleased to notify that the procedure laid herein under this Notification shall apply to all the Private Un-Aided Institutions and Institutes under Deemed Universities in the State running MBBS and BDS courses except Institutes Shri Guru Gobind Singh Tercentenary University Budhera, Gurgaon (Private University) namely SGT Medical College Hospital & Research Institute and SGT Dental Hospital & Research.
- iii Any admissions made in exception to this notification under the circumstances as elaborated above shall be acknowledged as 'validly admitted students'.
- iv It is notified that 50% of the Undergraduate seats will be for Open Merit Category and the remaining 50% of the seats will be for Management Category. Out of 50% of Management Category seats, 15% seats will be in the Non Resident Indian (NRI) Category for Private unaided Medical/ Dental Institutions/Deemed Universities in the State.
- v The Governor of Haryana is further pleased to authorize Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma, University of Health Sciences, Rohtak to conduct web based Online Counselling as per Merit of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET)-2016 for admission to both Open Merit Category seats as well as Management Category seats subject to verification of eligibility and original documents by the Admission Committee.

However, the online counselling result shall be provisional and final confirmation of seats and allotment of Colleges/ Institutes will be done by the Admission Committee after physical verification of eligibility and original documents.

Process for Admission to Open Merit Category:-

- a. All admissions will be made on the basis of the relative merit in the NEET-2016.
- b. The number of seats and their distribution shall be notified by the Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
- c. The admission to Reserved Category candidates will be given as per State Reservation Policy.
- d. All students desiring admissions shall apply online through web-portal. The details of web portal including dates for inviting online applications and counselling schedule shall be duly publicized as well as uploaded on the website of Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
- e. Candidates applying on the basis of NEET-2016 should fulfil the eligibility criteria for being granted admissions as fixed under NEET-2016.
- f. The relative merit, among such candidates desiring to seek admissions, shall be drawn by Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak through HKCL (Agency approved by the State Government) from the candidates who have applied for the online counselling on the basis of merit of Haryana State Merit of NEET-2016 for all such candidates who have cleared the NEET-2016 with or above such distinction as has been declared as minimum eligibility criteria of proficiency for granting admissions. In case,

NEET-2016 candidates of Haryana State Merit are not available then the admission will be made from the All India Merit of NEET-2016.

g. Details of the Admission Process for various courses is as follows:-

MBBS Preference for admission is as below:-
1) Haryana State Merit of NEET-2016
2) All India Merit of NEET-2016

BDS Preference for admission is as below:-
1) Haryana State Merit of NEET-2016
2) All India Merit of NEET-2016

h. The schedule of counselling, admission and start of classes shall be in conformity with the schedule laid down by Medical Council of India/ Dental Council of India/ State Government.

i. The Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Medical Education and Research Department will be the final Appellate Authority in all admissions related disputes for all institutions and his decision shall be final.

j. In case of a tie between two or more candidates having equal Marks/ Merit, the inter-se-ranking of such candidates shall be determined as follows:-

a. A candidate with higher aggregate marks in Biology in the respective qualifying examination will be ranked higher.

b. If there is a tie then a candidate having higher marks in aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) will be ranked higher in merit.

c. Still if there is tie than a candidate older in age will be put higher in merit.

k. The allotment of the Institution/College shall be made strictly as per merit prepared/drawn by Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak on the basis of the NEET-2016 merit of the candidate in the State list/All India list, as the case may be and the choice of the College/Institute filled up by the candidate online shall be taken as final.

l. However, the online counselling result shall be provisional and final confirmation of seats and allotment of Institute will be done by the Admission Committee after physical verification eligibility and original documents.

m. Following shall be the composition of the Admission Committee:

n. The final allotment of the College/Institute to the candidates shall be made by the Admission Committee as per the Haryana State Merit/All India Merit list prepared by the University on the basis of the NEET-2016.

- o. Personal appearance of the candidate in front of the Admission Committee at Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak shall be compulsory.
- p. In case there remains any vacancy under open merit category in any College/Institution after the first round of admissions/ counselling made in terms of this Notification, a second round of counselling shall be held. In case, the seats still remain vacant, such vacant seats shall be converted to Management category seats and filled up as per the directions of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, the Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India and as per procedure notified by the State Government for filling up of Management Category. However, even under this dispensation, admission shall be made only on the basis of merit of NEET-2016 and no admissions will be made after the last date prescribed for making admissions.
- q. Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak may fix and charge processing fee for counselling and further, determine and charge the fee for online applications etc. which will be duly notified.

Process for Admission to Management Category:-

- a) Admissions to Management Category will be done strictly in a fair and transparent manner by adhering to the directions of the Government of India, the Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India, and as the State Government as the case may be, i.e. on the basis of merit of the NEET-2016. All admissions will be made on the basis of the relative merit in the NEET-2016 conducted by the Authority notified by the Government of India.
- b) Details of the Admission Process for various courses is as follows:-

- c) All students desiring admissions shall apply online through web-portal. The details of web portal including dates for inviting online applications and counselling schedule shall be duly publicized as well as uploaded on the website of Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
- d) Candidates applying on the basis of NEET-2016 should fulfil the eligibility criteria for being granted admissions as fixed under NEET-2016.
- e) The relative merit, among such candidates desiring to seek admissions, shall be drawn by Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma, University of Health Sciences, Rohtak through HKCL (Agency approved by the State Government) from the candidates who have applied for the online counselling on the basis of merit of All India Merit of NEET-2016 for all such candidates who have cleared the NEET-2016 with or above such distinction as has been declared as minimum eligibility criteria of proficiency for granting admissions. In case, NEET-2016 candidates of All India Merit are not available then the admission will be made from the State Merit of NEET-2016.
- f) The online counselling result shall be provisional and final confirmation of seat and allotment of College/Institute will be done by the Admission Committee during physical verification of eligibility and original documents.
- g) The final allotment of the Colleges shall be made by the Admission Committee as per the merit list prepared by the University on the basis of the NEET-2016.
- h) Following shall be the composition of the Admission Committee:-

- i) Personal appearance of the candidate in front of the Admission Committee at Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak shall be compulsory. Admitted students shall pay the fees and other charges for all types of seats as per rates of the Fee and other charges fixed by the Government of Haryana from time to time.
- j) Final number of seats under each category in each institute shall be available on the authorized web portal and the website of Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
- k) In case there is a vacancy after the first round of admission/counselling for any reason, such seats shall be filled through the same process in the second/third counselling as the case may be. However, no such subsequent process shall be undertaken after the prescribed last date of admission.
- l) The schedule of counselling, admission and start of classes shall be in conformity with the schedule laid down by Medical Council of India/Dental Council of India and State Government.
- m) The Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Medical Education & Research Department will be the final Appellate Authority in all cases of admissions related disputes for all institutions and in case of any dispute, decision made by him shall be final.
- n) Left over seats under NRI category shall also be filled under the Management category.

Admission to NRI Category:-

All admissions in Private institutes under NRI category seats shall be based on the merit of NEET-2016.

- Category-I: Actual NRI Candidates who originally belonged to the State of Haryana.
- Category-II: Children of NRI who originally belonged to Haryana State.
- Category-III: Actual NRI Candidates who originally belonged to an Indian State or Union Territories other than Haryana.
- Category-IV: Children of NRIs who originally belonged to an India State and Union Territories other than Haryana.
- a) If sufficient number of eligible candidates under first category are available then they will be admitted first even if students under subsequent category are higher in merit.
- b) The NRI students will have to give a Bank Guarantee/Surety Bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in instalment as provided.
- c) Any seats remaining vacant under NRI category till the last date of admission shall go to the Management category.

- d) It will be obligatory on the part of the University to provide registration number to all candidates once duly admitted.

Fee Structure for all categories of seats:-[The existing fee structure is in the process of revision and the new fee structure after due approval of Government would be published before counselling for which a separate corrigendum will be issued]

NB: Two Colleges namely MM Institute of Medial Sciences and Research & Maharishi Markandeshwar College of Dental Sciences and Research are affiliated to Deemed University namely Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Mullana, Ambala have been following their own fee structure, so far. Details of fee structure for respective courses in these institutes will be notified later on.

- a) The Fee will be payable on annual basis at the time of admission.
- b) Fee will be deposited by the successful candidates to the respective institute in the shape of demand draft. The fee shall be refunded/adjusted if the candidate is shifted from one institute to another be it Private to Government or Private to Private Institute in the subsequent counselling. If the said fee is not refunded/adjusted within 15 days, the concerned Institute will be liable to pay bank interest as well as penal interest to the said students as laid by Reserve Bank of India.

General Instructions:-

- a) Admitted students shall pay the fees and other charges for all types of seats as per the rates of the Fee and other charges fixed by the Government of Haryana from time to time for Private Unaided Medical and Dental Institutions and the fee as fixed by Private/Deemed Universities for the institutes falling under their purview.
- b) Final number of seats under each category in each institute shall be available on the authorized web portal and the website of Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
- c) The admitted candidates will have to deposit fee in the shape of Bank draft issued in favour of

- d The admission shall be made to only those Institutes which are approved from the concerned councils or statutory body or the concerned authority, as the case may be and affiliated to the University which has applied for affiliation and/or for approval of competent authority(ies) in accordance with the last date as prescribed by Government of India/Medical Council of India/State Government. The institutes that are unable to get affiliation and such approval from all authorities shall not be considered for counselling.
- e Bank Guarantee of Rs. 1.00 Lakh will be taken from the BDS students at the time of admission to prevent students from leaving the course midway, leading to vacancy in the seat for the next years and thus causing financial loss to the Institution. If a candidate thus leaves the course the bank guarantee shall be encashed by the respective institute.

Note:

This notification supersedes all earlier notifications issued by Government/procedure for admission adopted by Private Un-Aided Medical and Dental Educational Institutions/Deemed Universities for MBBS and BDS courses.



